





This loving family takes care of the dogs in their neighborhood and are very keen about their wellbeing. They got five dogs that they take care for, neutered and are very happy with the results. ANIMAL WELFARE TRAININGS CONDUCTED



A training session was conducted by the National Veterinary Foundation at our shelter. NVF Team Dr. Lakshmi and Dr. Johnson, conducted the session along with Dr. Bonnie Campbellfor qualified and licensed veterinarians only.

FIRST AID TRAINING



First Aid Training is an initiative of Blue Cross of Hyderabad that helps volunteers learn the basic requirements of first aid to help an animal in need. After the Ambulance Rescue shut three years ago,

we found that animals with small and minor injuries or illness could be helped locally and recovered much faster in their own territories. Rescue volunteers with first aid training organized themselves into groups and teams, formed new rescue identities to ensure no animal went without help. During the Covid lockdown we are happy to say animal injuries due to road accidents came to a complete stop.

It is a six-weekend scheduled program where the trainee learns animal-handling techniques, understands behaviour of stray dogs and learns practically how to give first aid. First Aid teams seen in the picture went to treat stray dogs on the road as a part of their practical. The main objective behind this training is to ensure that animals get timely help. First Aid on time can save a life!





In the month of June 2019 First Aid Training for Batch 4 started and many people from different areas had applied for it but only 17 got selected for the training. Now they actively attend first aid cases in their respective areas.



First Aid Training Certificates were presented by (in August 2019) by Mr. RK Rao and Amala Akkineni to the volunteers who completed the training successfully.

SESSION ON DOG TRAINING



Dog Training is an essential and key part of having a pet. Emphasizing this and many other important aspects of dog training such as animal behaviour, socializing and handling techniques was Ms. Lindsay McKeon from USA at a session on campus, in June. She explained how to approach a new dog and how to train a pet, while also answering queries.



ADOPTION DAY



On Adoption Days many loving families adopt Indian puppies and dogs; and kittens and gave them a loving home. It is our platform to provide homes for homeless pups, where foster caretakers came with their puppies to make best use of our platform.

Note: We do not house puppies at our shelter. We do not encourage or advise groups of puppies to be housed together. Puppies must be vaccinated before being housed in an animal shelter.

Adoption Day ensures pups move from a safe foster care home to the family that adopts them.

There is no better way to spread happiness and joy for animals than by adopting them, and giving them a loving home and family. Here are a few glimpses of the animals adopted into loving homes, by the wonderful people!

Hima bindu Madala, one of our regular and dedicated volunteers, shares her experience of been a part of the adoption day activities.

"On the 29th of December, we hosted our monthly adoption drive at the shelter where we provide a support to foster parents to put their rescued puppies and kittens up for adoption. Families who are looking for a loving pet, visit to adopt them. We had 34 rescues come in, out of which 28 found good homes to grow up in. Other volunteers were ready to receive them, providing puppies and kittens with food and water.











Adoption Day in conducted in the adoption space sponsored by 'MARS' (Pedigree) and the family carry home a bag of puppy food to get started.

"Our volunteers continued to look after the puppies and kittens for the entire duration of the drive, chatted up with some of the fosters and were moved with emotion when listening to some of their rescue stories. It's a miracle how a number of these animals overcame all their struggles and fought with all their might to live on, and to find a family who will love them with all their heart and being.

"We host these drives in hopes to educate the public about Indian dogs who have been left on the streets to die, due to the rise in demand for breed dogs. We hope that these drives allow us to educate them about how very marvelous Indian dogs can be when it comes to intelligence, friendship, or even maintenance!"

Our Education Officer Mr. Sai Pavan, regularly conducts sessions at various schools across the city. The session for school students is called "Understanding Animals" and is supported by Pedigree-MARS India. The session covers what animals say with their body language. The session also prepares students how to help animals, and how to ensure not to get bitten by a dog, and what to do in the case of a dog bite, for their safety. Mr. Pavan successfully gave awareness sessions to 2000+ students in the span of four months. More schools are interested in conducting such awareness programs in their respective schools too and approach us. This is a positive and welcome sign for holistic education.

We have around 250 volunteers who help us with our activities regularly, apart from 205 new volunteers this year and the interest and support they show towards Blue Cross of Hyderabad makes usmore energetic.

This year we implemented the Animal Birth Control for Stray Dogs program in the areas of Kukatpally, KPHB Colony and Jubilee Hills, for total dogs of 4675 male,5012 female i.e. A total of 9687 dogs thereby reducing the population of 500,000 dogs in the future.





SOURCES OF FUNDS - PROJECT WISE






